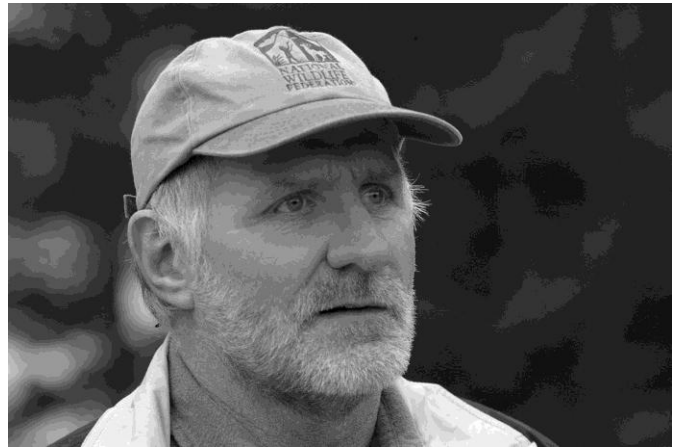

Each year, Tom Ulrich dazzles his audiences with amazing photographs and humorous narration. He will take us on a photographic journey of the year 2009 in the life of a wildlife photographer. This year's focus will include wildlife from the Pantanal of Brazil and all of North America with a special feature on the hummingbirds of Ecuador. His narration includes insight on photo



technique and animal behavior and is always riddled with humor.
